

Notes on Attendance at Area Sites/Attractions and Events 2008 versus 2007 – self-reported analysis

Sites/Attractions

- 1. Rock Cut State Park Slight drop in attendance attributed to high gas prices and poor spring weather.
- 2. Rockford IceHogs Increase in attendance due to additional games for playoffs in 2008, and fewer games in 2007 because of MetroCentre renovations.
- 3. Rockford RiverHawks Reported attendance is for RiverHawks games. Attendance at Road Ranger stadium for other events is 152,599.
- Coronado Performing Arts Center The increase in attendance reflects a new accounting system by CPAC. Numbers had formerly been reported by the MetroCentre.
- 5. Klehm Arboretum & Botanic Garden Increase in attendance due to more booked events and weddings. General attendance was down due to rainy weather.
- 6. Rockford Art Museum The higher attendance in 2007 can be partly attributed to the Vallien Glass exhibit in the spring, which brought about 10,000 visitors.
- 7. Mendelssohn Performing Arts Center In-house attendance was 4,747. Off-site attendance was 3,719.
- 8. Davis Park Three events were held: "Light the Night, Rockford", Rockford Marathon, and Fourth of July SkyConcert.
- 9. Erlander Home Museum Attendance reported is for Midsommar Fest and Lucia Fest. Museum visitor attendance was not available.
- 10. Ski Broncs Attendance was down because of excessive rain which affected use of the river.
- 11. Trolley Car Because of fire damage, the Trolley did not run in 2008.
- 12. Graham Ginestra Home The home was not open to the public in 2008.

Events

- 13. AirFest Onsite attendance was 75,000. Off-site attendance is estimated at 100,000.
- 14. Illinois Snow Sculpting Competition Estimate is based on City of Rockford vehicle counter, plus 2,000 walkers.
- 15. Home & Garden Showcase First time attendance reported; event was new for 2008.
- 16. Cider & Cinnamon Fall Arts & Craft Show Attendance was down due to rainy weather.
- 17. Keith Classics & Chrome Car Show Increase in attendance may be attributed to more publicity in print, radio and television.
- 18. Head of the Rock Regatta Attendance includes 1,100 athletes and 6,000 spectators.
- 19. Klehm Garden Fair Attendance was down due to rainy weather.
- 20. Rockford Speedway Trailer Race, June Attendance was down due to rainy weather.
- 21. Stars & Guitars Summer Concerts Attendance was down due to rainy weather.
- 22. Paleofest Burpee Museum General attendance was down, but participation in classes and workshops was up.
- 23. Greenwich Village Art Fair Attendance was down due to rainy weather.
