

# Notes on Differences in Attendance at Area Sites, 2004 Versus 2003 (self reported analysis)

- Rock Cut State Park numbers declined due to a wet spring and the beach was closed
- Discovery Center numbers were increased due to the inclusion of traveling exhibits. Discovery
  Center numbers from the past have also included attendance numbers from traveling exhibits.
  Numbers were down in 2003 because traveling exhibits went to smaller venues this year, thus
  less people
- Tinker Swiss Cottage numbers were lower because involvement w/after school programs ceased in May of 2004
- 317 Art Gallery included a count of openings only
- Forest City Queen numbers were down due to the closure of the Rock River in June because of high water
- Ski Broncs numbers were lower due to the closure of the Rock River in June because of high water
- Anderson Japanese Gardens saw an increase in numbers because of a#1 ranking by Roth
  Journal of Japanese Gardening and an increase in marketing by the RACVB and the Rockford
  Register Star
- Midway Village saw an increase in numbers due to programming and publicity
- WXRX/Budweiser Wing-Ding numbers were low due to thunderstorm and tornado warnings that weekend
