ROCKFORD, IL —In Rockford, Illinois, the opportunity to experience a high-quality performing arts show is never in short supply. From dance to symphony orchestra to plays, Rockford has something for every cultural craving.

World-class Performance Arts Venues

Coronado Performing Arts Center

You don't have to travel to big cities like Chicago or New York to find unique performance arts venues. At the <u>Coronado Performing Arts Center</u> in downtown Rockford, your experience begins the moment you walk into the lobby of this ornate movie palace and vaudeville hall. Built in 1927 for \$1.5 million and restored and renovated in 2000 for \$18.5 million, the Coronado is a delightful example of an "atmospheric-style" theater with gilded Spanish castles, Italian villas and Chinese dragons in relief on the sides of a starry false sky.

While worth seeing for just its opulent interior, the <u>Coronado</u> is also host to high quality shows throughout the year, including an annual line-up of performances presented by the <u>Rockford Symphony Orchestra</u>, the <u>Rockford Dance Company</u> and the <u>Rockford Coronado Concert Association</u>. The Coronado also presents a wide variety of musical and entertainment shows, from comedians like Jerry Seinfeld to entertainers like famous illusionist David Copperfield. Event parking is available across from the theater in the ramp on the east side of North Main Street for just \$5 or for free in nearby city parking lots. Located at 314 N. Main St., the <u>Coronado Performing Arts Center</u> has been named one of Illinois' 150 Great Places by the American Institute of Architects, Illinois Council. This prestigious award is given to places that have been identified by leading architects as contributing to their communities' quality of life. Coronado claimed the title of the "Top Wonder of the United States" in a 2010 online contest by AOL and the U.S. Travel Association. Rockford's unique theatre-going experiences don't end with the opulent Coronado Performing Arts Center. On warm, clear summer nights, theatre-goers can experience performances beneath a starry night sky at <u>Starlight Theatre</u>, Rockford's oldest outdoor summer theatre. Starlight Theatre features more than a thousand seats, new seating, improved stage, and its most-famous architectural element: a stunningly artistic retractable roof that opens up like a blooming flower. Located at 3301 N. Mulford Road, Starlight Theatre offers four different musical productions in June and July. Like the Coronado Performing Arts Center, Starlight Theatre has been named one of Illinois' 150 Great Places by the American Institute of Architects, Illinois Council.
