



Corrected Anglers to Cast Lines in Rockford for Fishing Tournament

Cabela's Helps Establish Region as Fishing Destination

What: The Rockford Region will host a Cabela's King Kat Fishing Tournament, one of 15 King Kat Trail

fishing events taking place this summer. Cabela's, the sporting goods retail giant, coordinates the

The park will serve as the home base for the tournament, with anglers fishing in the Rock River.

Why: The tournament will draw nearly 300 anglers and fans from around the Midwest and other parts of

the country. They will fill 450 hotel room nights and generate an estimated \$80,000 for local

businesses.

This is the first time in recent history the region has hosted a fishing event of this caliber. The tournament establishes the region as a fishing destination and makes the Rockford Region a

contender for similar events in the future.

weigh-in line by 4 p.m. To help preserve the sport, only live fish will be weighed in, and all fish will

be released during or after the tournament.
