Opening day includes:

Calvagna is a well-known jazz guitarist and has won RAMI and Best of Rockford awards both as an individual performer and for his work with the band Opan Jii. Youngblood also is a Best of Rockford winner, and has performed with the bands Grooveasuarus and Mr. Big Stuff.
- Activities: YMCA's climbing wall will be on hand, and Midway Village will also provide a family activity.
