Careful planning went into the newly remodeled CIC to ensure ease of accessibility and a more comfortable atmosphere. Large bookcases have been repurposed and converted into hanging brochure racks to open up the space for more souvenirs and merchandise. Guests can enjoy a cup of complimentary coffee while creating a customized Rockford itinerary. The knowledgeable staff and volunteers are able to recommend specific places in the area to shop and dine that are exclusive to Rockford. Bus tickets to and from O'Hare Airport and Downtown Chicago can also be purchased at the CIC. This satellite resource hub gives visitors and locals a better understanding of what the Rockford region has to offer.

Along with a new infrastructure, there is also a wide variety of products made right here in the Rockford area for purchase at the CIC, making great holiday gifts. Snack bags of Mrs. Fisher's and Ole Salty's potato chips along with bags of Jadabug coffee are restocked frequently and fresh daily. With a goal to continue offering original products made locally, the CIC now carries authentic gift items made from Rockford Etsy vendors Candle Crest, The Paper Button, Robayre and 3KDesigns. Rockford-specific souvenirs include pens, leather padfolios, flashlights, sunglasses, post-it note holders, post cards, t-shirts and messenger bags, just to name a few. Although not made in Rockford, "Made in the USA" sock monkeys are also available for sale.
