Collectively, participants, coaches and fans visiting the region for the tournaments will spend nearly \$430,000 during their stay.

Attendance: 16 teams from around the country with more than 1,000 players, fans and guests expected.

Economic Impact: Estimated 1,175 room nights and \$211,500 (Estimated Economic Impact).
