Park and ride: Carmel, Fishers commuter buses to run next Saturday

Commuter express buses from Carmel and Fishers, which usually offer service only on weekdays, will be running on Saturday, Feb. 4, to ease Super Bowl-related congestion in Downtown Indy.

The service is offered by the Central Indiana Regional Transportation Authority and Miller Trailways.

The Express Bus service will pick up passengers at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Feb. 4 and head downtown. Shuttles will leave from the Meijer store in Carmel (intersection of Pennsylvania and Carmel Drive) and in Fishers at Prairie View at Crosspoint (northeast corner of 106th Street and Lantern Road).

The shuttle will drop off passengers at the northeast corner of Illinois and New York streets.

For the return trip, shuttles will depart from Illinois and New York at 4 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

Saturday one-way tickets are \$10 and available on board the bus. It will be cash only with exact change required.

The Express Bus service also will increase during the coming week. In addition to the morning and evening rush hour routes, an extra bus that will leave the Carmel and Fishers departure points at 1 p.m. to travel downtown. There will be an additional return trip as well, from the Illinois and New York stop at 7:30 p.m.

All weekday one-way tickets are \$5 and available on board the bus -- cash only, exact change. For more information: www.indyexpressbus.com.
