Here are a few ways to experience the best of Hamilton County's autumnal offerings:

- 1. By water Rent from White River Canoe Company in Noblesville for a crisp morning or afternoon spent on White River under a canopy of fall hues.
- 2. By bicycle Pick up the paved Monon Trail in Carmel or Westfield for a ride through miles of fiery foliage.
- 3. By foot Head to
 Strawtown Koteewi in
 Noblesville for a walk or run on
 eight miles of crushed
 limestone trails through
 Hamilton County's largest park.

4. By rail – Board the Hamilton Harvest Train in in Fishers beginning Oct. 4 for a rail journey through the Indiana countryside, and pick some pumpkins while you're at it!

5. By air – Soar 350 feet above the county in a giant helium balloon at <u>Conner Prairie</u> to see fall colors more than 20 miles away.

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
