Bundle up with a cup of hot chocolate and hop on a carriage or hayride through the magical display of holiday lights. The lights glow from the Lighting Ceremony at 6 pm on Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 27) through year's end. Carriage rides are offered Dec 6,13, 20. Hayrides are offered Dec. 5,12,19. Ice skate Nov. 27-29, Dec. 5-6, 12-13, 19-20. On Dec. 7,14, 21, visit "Santa Paws" at Santa's House and get your photo made with your pet. Call 828-248-5200.
