## Festival Brings 28 Films and 3 days of Special Events to Grand Rapids

Grand Rapids, Mich. March 9, 2017—The Grand Rapids Film Festival (GRFF) returns with unique events this <u>April 6-8</u>.

"This weekend aims to bring the film community of Grand Rapids together through networking opportunities and celebrating film" said Jen Shaneberger President and CEO of GRFF.

- Thursday, April 6: GRFF partners with PechaKuchaGR and asks 12 filmmakers to share the story of "how film transformed their lives" in the infamous 20X20 format. Speakers include: Shane Hagedorn, Sloan Inns, Michael McCallum, Lucas Miles, Bret Miller, Julian Newman, Tom Norton, John Otterbacher, John Harper Philbin, Kathleen Sindorf, and Ella Swift. - Friday, April 7: Fashion and Music for Film (F&M) returns (video of previous year) in partnership with
  Kendall College of Art and Design's Fashion Department (KCAD), Division16 audio and visual company,
  and AB Apparel. The event exhibits three music videos, each followed by fashion inspired by the videos

- Saturday, April 8: The Wealthy Street Theatre serves as the hub for the screening of 28 films. Both the
  Wege and Micro theaters host films. Screenings of films from all over the world, including Grand Rapids,
  run from 12pm to 11:30pm. Highlights include: Michigan made film <u>Something Fun</u>, <u>Watch This</u> by Grand
  Rapids Native currently residing in Burbank, CA Richard Turke, and <u>Wintery Spring</u> a short from Egypt. A
