

2017 SHOOTOUT FOR SOLDIERS OHIO EVENT MOVES TO FORTRESS OBETZ; EXPECTED TO BREAK FUNDRAISING AND TURNOUT RECORDS

The 24-Hour Lacrosse Event Benefiting American Veterans Will Take Place at the New Ohio Machine Stadium

Columbus (June XX, 2017) – Shootout for Soldiers (SFS) is expected to break previous attendance and fundraising records in its third year in Ohio as it moves to the new stadium for the Ohio Machine, Fortress Obetz, July 15-16, 2017.



The 24-hour charity lacrosse event is comprised of back-to-back one hour lacrosse games with the intent of encouraging interaction between American veterans and civilians while raising proceeds to support our nation's heroes in a light-hearted and casual way.

Shootout for Soldiers Ohio, in coordination with the Ohio Machine home game vs. Denver the same day, will be a family-friendly event with live music including The Dave Walters Band, Midlife Crisis and Madison Rising, a diverse range of food such as Bob's Backyard BBQ, The Mess Hall, The Wooden Shoe Coffee and Short North Bagel and Deli along with exciting activities for attendees of all ages. SFS will kick-off with Opening Ceremonies July 15 at noon and concludes with Closing Ceremonies July 16 at 1 p.m.
