- Aug. 3: 1980s Pop/Rock Night featuring Stone in Love, a Journey Tribute band

Just 30 minutes northeast of Vancouver, Wash., near Battle Ground and Brush Prairie, the 63acre Alderbrook Park is well known as a popular wedding and event venue because of its expansive forest, inviting fields, beautiful lake and dock, two bridal houses, myriad of reception areas, parking for 1,000 cars and capacity for 6,000 people. The expansive park also includes a swimming pool, a miniature golf course and a volleyball court as well as childrence amenities including a maze and a life-size pirate ship play structure.

The park gates will open at 5:30 p.m. and bands will perform from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Tickets will be on sale starting July 1 from Brown Paper Tickets (<u>www.brownpapertickets.com/</u>) and are \$30 for families, \$10 for individuals, and \$5 for children younger than 12.
