12th Annual Chowderfest To Be Held In Saratoga Springs, New York

A Record Breaking 56 Participants!

Saratoga Springs, NY – Enjoy some winter fun and some great food at the 12th Annual Chowderfest held in Saratoga Springs, NY on Saturday, February 6th, 2010 from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – the event is coordinated by the Saratoga Convention and Tourism Bureau. This event also features a Dog Chow Down for hungry canines. Special getaway packages are also available for the event.

Visitors can pick up a ballot and taste chowders from 56 participating restaurants (10 more than last year!) and vote for their favorite. Each sample of chowder is \$1, and is paid directly to the establishment. Valid ballots need 5 stickers from participating businesses and can be turned in to the Saratoga Springs Visitor Center or the Saratoga Arts Center. For an additional \$7, Chowderfest attendees can take home an official long-sleeve Chowderfest T-shirt with a completed ballot. Visitors can also bring their four-legged family members as there are 3 participants serving dog chowder. The popular Dog Chow Down will take place at 1:00 p.m. at the Saratoga Downtowner Motel. A Saint Bernard, courtesy of the Saratoga Animal Shelter, will be picking the winner!
