### GTO ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA INTERNATIONAL MEET IN SARATOGA

Saratoga Springs, New York---The 29<sup>th</sup> Annual GTO Association of America International Meet, hosted by the Electric City Chapter, is taking place on July 15<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> with first arrivals coming on July 14<sup>th</sup>. The event will feature more than 200 classic Pontiac GTO automobiles that were built from 1964-1974 with limited models built in 2004-2006. The cars are known for being the "small car with the big engine" and were built for the performance market. The week-long events are expected to bring about 2,000 people total to the local area and more than 1,000 of them will be coming in from across the country.

#### Things you need to know:

#### Road Closings and Parking Restrictions

- Maple Avenue closed 7 am 7 pm Tuesday-Saturday from Saratoga Springs City Center, just north of Ellsworth Jones Place to the corner of Rock and Maple
  - Access to the City lot is available and deliveries to the City Center can be accomplished
- Ellsworth Jones Place one-way traffic (toward Broadway) only Thursday AND Saturday for GTO arrivals and departures
- No overnight public parking entire week on Maple from southern entrance of City Center parking lot to Rock Street

#### • Events All Week – Open to the public

- Public areas are open, including Saratoga Springs City Center Parking lots, where vendors will be set up. GTOAA requests that people be <u>respectful</u> and recognize this is a national show
- <u>Only</u> GTOAA paid participants are allowed in the seminars inside The Saratoga Hilton
- This is one of the first years the general public has been allowed to view events

- Tuesday the 15<sup>th</sup> -- Early Bird Event -- BBQ at Saratoga Brewery
  - Open to the public
  - \$15/plate
  - Limited parking available on site
- Wednesday the 16<sup>th</sup> -- Saratoga Automobile Museum Picnic
  - Cars on display
  - Open to the public (with admission required for non-GTO convention attendees)
  - One of every GTO (each year it was manufactured) on display

## • Thursday the 17<sup>th</sup> -- Lebanon Valley Dragways event

- 1 ½ hours from Saratoga
- 9-3 pm
- Cars will be raced
- Open to all Pontiacs
- Race or watch the event
- Friday the 18<sup>th</sup> --Autocross event
  - Behind Dick's Sporting Goods at the Wilton Mall, Saratoga
  - Open to the public

## • Friday the 18<sup>th</sup> -- Concours

- 70 Concours cars on display inside the Saratoga Springs City Center; admission is \$5.00 a person
- Best bet for public to see the best of the best GTOs on display, including 10 specialty cars

#### • Saturday the 19th -- Popular Vote Day

- 150 cars on display outside The Saratoga Hilton parking lot; free and open to the public
- All day ends at 3 pm
