- A special thank you to Jay Sandine and the Rockford Park District for recognizing RACVB at their recent board of directors meeting.
- Stroll on State planning is going strong. More information will be shared at the September meeting, however, two of the additions this year include partnering with Fleet Feet for a 5k run the morning of Stroll and a greater parade with floats and marching bands. Sponsorships are ahead of last year's total and at about 50% of this year's total goal. Please share potential sponsors with John.
- The bi-annual citizen survey will begin on October 1. RACVB will be partnering with Transform Rockford and the City of Rockford to send one survey with questions for all organizations. The process is completed by U of I College of Medicine and ensures evenly distributed results.
- Calendar sales are underway for a project that will help fund Forrest City Beautiful. The project came at no cost to RACVB but 100% of proceeds will come to us. Businesses have the opportunity to buy in bulk, and several retailers will sell them as well.
- Tough Mudder and Toughest Mudder will be hosted at the Rockford Airport on August 26. 13,000 athletes are expected. CBS is in town filming the event.
- Convention of Jehovah Witnesses went well. They have already inquired about the possibility of returning for future years.
- Paint the Town Green 2018 has been confirmed for July 13 at Klehm Arboretum.
- The next meeting will be on Thursday, September 28 due to scheduling conflicts on Wednesday.
