	Day 1

6pm	Host a welcome dinner for your group in the taproom of one of Asheville's newest and most beautiful breweries – <b>Sierra Nevada Brewery</b> . From fresh produce grown onsite to their signature farm-to-table entrees, it's more than just the great beer that makes this a memorable group mealtime.
	Day 2
9am	Spend the day visiting <b>Biltmore</b> , a 250-room chateau nestled in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Asheville. From May 17 <sup>th</sup> until October 7 <sup>th</sup> , the <b>Chihuly at Biltmore</b> exhibit will feature breathtaking large-scale glass sculptures in an equally breathtaking setting: the historic gardens of America's Largest Home®. Enjoy lunch at <b>Stable Café</b> before visiting <b>Antler Hill Village</b> and the award-winning <b>Biltmore Winery</b> .
3pm	"Get Your Hands Dirty" at <b>The Village Potters</b> where you can create your own custom piece of art with the help of local, professional potters. In addition, tour other nearby studios in the well-known <b>River Arts District</b> where a diverse group of more than 180 working artists are housed in 22 former factories and historical buildings nestled along a mile-long stretch of the French Broad River.

Biltmore Industries began at this site in 1917 and became the largest producer of hand-woven wool in the world by 1930. The 11-acre campus includes Grovewood Gallery, 9 working artist studios, a sculpture garden, the North Carolina Homespun Museum, and Asheville's only antique car museum.

6pm Conclude your visit with the greatest work of art there is, a colorful sunset at the **Crest Mountain Dinner Show**. This full service dinner buffet includes entertainment by local buskers and bluegrass musicians and is sure to leave a lasting impression on your art-lovers.
