Next stop, <u>Bergey's Corn Maze</u> you and your family can experience a fun filled afternoon trying to find your way through this scenic maze. Come enjoy our largest corn maze ever! Includes inmaze photo ops, smart phone trivia and prizes, wagon rides, sunflower patch, pedal tractor course, corn cob shooter, sports area and a NEW cotton patch! Afterwards enjoy lunch at <u>Bergey's Breadbasket and More</u>. This family-owned farm offers made on-site ice cream and a variety of produce and fresh-cut flowers grown right on the farm.

On to <u>Deep Creek Lock Park</u>. This heavily wooded, 25 acre site with a combination pedestrian bridge/elevated walkway system to traverse a tidal inlet and marsh area. The kid's will marvel in this intriguing educational venture.

Enjoy dinner at Chesapeake's famous <u>Wicker's Crab Pot Seafood</u>. Family owned restaurant with a heritage in the seafood industry for over 60 years. Owner, Ray Wicker Jr. is a fourth generation waterman who has been working the waters of the Chesapeake Bay and its

tributaries for over 30 years. The Wicker family tradition goes back to great granddad John Wicker Sr. who crabbed and shed soft shells as far back as the 1940's. Roy Wicker followed in his father's love for crabbing and opened the Blue Channel Crab House in the 1950's.

Day Three

Enjoy breakfast at your host hotel then a short 20 minute drive to the <u>Adventure Park at</u> <u>Virginia Aquarium</u>. This park boasts 15 aerial tree top trails with 165 obstacles including zip lines with 6 levels of difficulty.

Enjoy a walk on the boardwalk at Virginia Beach! There's nothing like a bike ride on the boardwalk for some true family adventure after grabbing a burger and dog.

Take another short drive to Norfolk and enjoy the <u>Virginia Zoo</u> that offers family fun, education and excitement for everyone.
