



# Design Competition Art at Live Oak Point Park

A Design Competition for Art at Live Oak Point Park is being facilitated by the Arts & Humanities Council of Charlotte County, Inc. (Charlotte Arts) in conjunction with The Art in the Park Collaborative and Charlotte County's Community Services, Facilities, Economic Development, Parks and Recreation, and Visitor and Convention Bureau.

Live Oak Point Park is a highly-visible park in the Gateway Corridor in Charlotte Harbor, located in Charlotte County, Florida. It is the first location identified for Charlotte County's "Art in the Park" program and is in the Charlotte Harbor Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) plan.

The art installation will be located on the west (23'8" x 8'5") and south walls (13'11" x 8'5") of the concrete restroom facility (see photo below), owned and maintained by Charlotte County.

There is no theme but, because the piece is outdoors in a waterfront park, art should be family-friendly and spark the interest of those who pass by.
