The craft beer scene in the Carolinas is thriving, and Greenville is no exception. Thomas Creek Brewery, Blue Ridge Brewing Co., and Quest Brewing Co. are all worth a visit. Also, moonshining has deep roots in the Upstate and dates back to the 1800s. Greenville is home to South Carolina's first micro-whiskey and legal moonshine distillery. Learn more about the

rich Appalachian heritage of moonshining at Dark Corner Distillery. Tour guests can also enjoy a sampling of their product, World's Best Moonshine.

If Dad's a baseball fan, consider a stop at the Shoeless Joe Jackson Museum and Baseball Library. Located in the house where Jackson lived and died, the museum highlights Jackson's life from textile worker as a child to legendary baseball player. His remarkable career is brought to life through photographs, books and artifacts.

Men and cars make a perfect combo – especially when said car is a BMW. Located 15 miles from Greenville, the BMW Manufacturing plant's museum (the Zentrum) is open to visitors and features guided tours.
