



PMVB Annual Report Headlines Fiscal Year 2017-18 Special Awards Presented and Valued Partners Honored

POCONO MOUNTAINS, PA, October 25, 2018 – The <u>Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau</u> (PMVB) held their Annual Report Luncheon for the 2017-18 fiscal year today at <u>Skytop Lodge</u>. The event presented the PMVB's work over the past year, while also acknowledging regional individual and partner organizations who have contributed substantially to the success of the hospitality and tourism industry in the Poconos.

The 2017-18 Annual Report outlined the multiple Bureau activities and initiatives over the past fiscal year. Here's the news:

- Visits to <u>PoconoMountains.com</u> are up, surpassing 4 million visits.
- <u>Blog</u> views have increased by 97.58% YoY.
- Two new marketing campaigns were launched: Pocono Television Network (PTN) and Pocono Mountains Magazine.
 - PTN is planned to run on a local TV station, featuring interviews with employees of Pocono Mountains attractions, weather updates across the region, and it displays suggested things to do and places to stay in the Poconos.
 - Hosts of Pocono Mountains Magazine, Chris and Ashley, showcase some of the Poconos' most unique attractions, lodging amenities, historic culture and more. These in-depth vignettes are aired on local and regional stations during the evening newscasts.
- All social media networks achieved growth; Instagram was the most substantial, increasing followers by 141% YoY.
- The PMVB worked with 22 different publications to increase brand awareness and drove earned media placements up by 63% YoY.
