- Victoria's capital, Melbourne is located around the shores of Port Phillip Bay. The city itself sits beside the Yarra River, about five kilometres from the bay
- Average temperature in Melbourne during summer is 25°C/78°F
- Melbourne's time zone is Australian Eastern Standard Time GMT plus 10 hours
- Daylight savings occurs from 7 October 2018 to 7 April 2019
- The currency is the Australian Dollar. Currency exchanges are available at Melbourne Airport, banks and other locations throughout the city
