Under his leadership, the organization underwent an elevated phase of growth and added \$1.5M to its operating budget.

Jones is excited to bring his operationally-savvy skillset and executive management style to the visitor industry. "I am very excited to join the GBCVB," said Jones. "Boston is an illustrious city filled with American history, tradition and new age innovation. I look forward to executing Martha's excellent vision to continue positioning Boston as a tier 1 meeting and visitor destination. Together we will showcase the people and places that make Boston one of the most amazing cities and regions in the nation."

The GBCVB Board of Directors, in partnership with Searchwide Global, implemented a rigorous vetting process that yielded several distinguished candidates for the EVP position. Ultimately, Aaron Jones' proven record in generating sustainable revenue streams through partnerships and strategic management, as well as his entrepreneurial leadership and roles with organizations such as the NFL, NFL Players Inc., NBA, and within the non-profit industry, separated him from the other excellent candidates.
