Sunrise Biscuit Kitchen has reopened at its East Franklin Street location after repairs due to an electrical fire.

Blue Dogwood Public Market is entering its second year with a couple North Carolina basics: barbecue and ice cream. Joining this summer will be **Big Belly Que** from chef **Garret Fleming**, who was the chef at the acclaimed Motto restaurant in downtown Durham before it closed in July 2017. The second new vendor is Burlington's **Smitty's Homemade Ice**Cream, which is returning to Chapel Hill and opening a satellite location at the food hall's bar. **Blue Dogwood** opened last June at 306 W.
