The Pennsylvania Capitol Complex is a National Historic Landmark dedicated in 1906 as a Palace of Art. Daily, free 30-minute guided tours reveal the stunning artwork, craftsmanship and various Renaissance designs capped by a spectacular dome that is a 1/5-scale replica of the one on St. Peter's Basilica in Rome.
