Two resorts open, others open this weekend

December 17, 2020 – Ski resorts across the <u>Pocono Mountains</u> are embracing the freshly fallen snow and frigid temperatures as they gear up for the 2020-2021 season. Blue Mountain Resort and Jack Frost Mountain opened last Friday, while the other resorts plan to open this weekend with the following tentative schedule:

- <u>Camelback Mountain</u> December 18, 2020
- Jack Frost Mountain December 11, 2020
- Shawnee Mountain Ski Area December 18, 2020
- Ski Big Bear at Masthope Mountain December 19, 2020
