200+ Job Seekers Attended Pocono Tourism Job Fair

Some candidates were hired on the spot yesterday

May 14, 2021 – The <u>Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau</u> (PMVB) hosted a region-wide hospitality job fair yesterday at three locations: <u>Blue Mountain Resort</u>, <u>The Inn at</u> <u>Woodloch</u>, and <u>Kalahari Resorts & Conventions</u>. More than 200 job seekers attended in-person, while others participated virtually. More than 90 employers, from the tourism industry and beyond, set up booths at the job fair. Many employers received applications from quality candidates, while other job seekers were hired on the spot.

"With the industry in dire need of employees, we are very happy with the outcome of this event," said Marlyn Kissner, VP of Membership and Community Relations, Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau.
