2021-2022 Travel Guide Helps Guests Plan Pocono Getaway Mass distribution underway across five states

June 10, 2021 – The <u>Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau</u> (PMVB) is pleased to announce the return of its highly-popular travel guide, "Pocono Mountains Magazine," for 2021-2022. Beginning this week, 200,000 copies are being distributed to 800+ locations throughout New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and Maryland.

The PMVB partnered with <u>Bailey Design & Advertising</u> to create the guide in both print and <u>digital</u> versions. The free publication is updated annually and helps guests plan their getaway to the Pocono Mountains with suggested itineraries, insider trip ideas, and a pullout map. The guide features information about Pocono small towns, tourism-related businesses and activities across the four-county region, and new for 2021-2022, a spread on <u>Pocono Television Network</u>. All listings highlight PMVB members and properties that pay the hotel tax within Wayne, Pike, Monroe, and Carbon counties.

The free guide can be found at high-traffic locations such as Pennsylvania welcome centers, <u>PMVB visitors centers</u>, two large travel shows in New York and Washington, D.C., rest areas, turnpike plazas, and AAA offices. Consumers can also <u>request to have a travel guide mailed directly to them.</u>
