## Pocono Mountains Named USA's 3<sup>rd</sup> Best Fall Foliage Destination

## USA TODAY 10Best announced winners today

September 10, 2021 – The <u>Pocono Mountains</u> has been named the <u>3rd Best</u> <u>Destination for Fall Foliage</u> in the USA TODAY 10Best Readers' Choice Awards 2021.

After a panel of experts and 10Best editors selected and announced the 20 nominees in early August, readers were able to cast their votes once daily for four weeks. The Poconos has been nominated in this contest several years in a row and ranked in the Top 10 each time, securing 8<sup>th</sup> place in 2020 and 4<sup>th</sup> place in 2019.

The Pocono Mountains is a great fourseason destination, with <u>fall</u> being a prime time to visit," said Chris Barrett, President/CEO of the Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau. Split into three distinct zones and updated every Thursday, the online forecast shows when and where leaves are projected to be at their peak across the Poconos.
