## Ocean House

Talk about pouring on the atmosphere on Thanksgiving Day. The iconic <u>Ocean</u> <u>House</u> in Rhode Island hosts a four-course Thanksgiving Dinner or buffet options (\$175 person or \$125 person, respectively) in the property's triple-5-star Relais & Chateaux surrounds (translation: dress up).

On the menu for the four-course meal? Think duck confit and specialty New England dishes. The buffet skews more gourmet-yet-classic Turkey Day, if that's the kind of comfort you're craving, with all the trimmings and traditional desserts.
