December 22, 2021 – Snow guns are hard at work as the Pocono Mountains' <u>six ski resorts</u> are either already open or getting ready to open for the 2021-2022 season. Camelback Mountain opens for the season today, with Shawnee Mountain and Ski Big Bear to follow this weekend.
