## Catalina Island Welcomes Disney Wonder to Avalon Port

Inaugural call on March 31 commemorated with a plaque exchange ceremony

**AVALON, CALIF.** – <u>Catalina Island</u> welcomed Disney Wonder to the port of Avalon for the first time on Thursday, March 31. Held on the rooftop patio of the Catalina Island Conservancy's Trailhead center, the location offered sweeping views of Avalon harbor. The ceremony was celebrated by a group of dignitaries, including Avalon Mayor Anni Marshall, Mayor ProTem Cinde Cassidy, City Councilmembers Lisa Lavelle and Michael Ponce, Love Catalina Island Tourism Authority President and CEO Jim Luttjohann, Harbormaster Orne Carstarphen, Avalon City Manager David Maistros, and more.
