He serves on the Board of Directors of Experience Grand Rapids and is immediate past president of the Kent County Hospitality Association.

"To be recognized by my peers in a market known for hospitality excellence is quite an honor," said Holst. "Big thanks to Experience Grand Rapids for this recognition and to my team at the Canopy by Hilton for advocating on my behalf."

The Joe Tomaselli Hotelier Award is awarded annually—with a pause during the pandemic—to the Kent County hotel general manager who represents the best of the best in the local tourism industry. The award recognizes the noteworthy contributions Mr. Tomaselli made to Grand Rapids through his outstanding work on behalf of Amway Hotel Corporation and through his leadership in the community. Mr. Tomaselli retired at the end of 2012 and is the former Chair of the Experience Grand Rapids' Board of Directors.
