## LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Missouri General Assembly completed their regular session last Friday afternoon. Fortunately, more bills made it through before they adjourned. Several of the Truly Agreed and Finally Passed legislation contain a few amendments. SB 13 Crawford, Dist. 28, Buffalo

- Modifies provisions relating to financial institutions

SB 20 Bernskoetter, Dist. 6, Jefferson City

- Modifies provisions relating to retirement

SB 25 Hough, Dist. 30, Springfield

- Authorizes an income tax deduction for certain federal grant money

SB 34 May, Dist. 4, St. Louis

- Authorizes school districts to offer elective social studies courses on the Hebrew Scriptures and the New Testament

SB 35 May, Dist. 4, St. Louis

- Related to the suspension of licenses for failure to comply with a child support order

SB 40 Thompson-Rehder, Dist. 27, Sikeston

- Modifies provisions relating to background checks

SB 45 Gannon, Dist. 3, De Soto

- Modifies provisions related to health care

SB 63 Roberts, Dist. 5, St. Louis

- Creates new provisions relating to financial institutions

SB 109 Bernskoetter, Dist. 6, Jefferson City

- Related to mining

SB 111 Bernskoetter, Dist. 6, Jefferson City

- Related to administration of state employees

SB 116 Brown, Dist. 16, Rolla

- Related to the disposition of the dead

SB 127 Thompson-Rehder, Dist. 27, Sikeston

- Enacts provisions relating to the designation of infrastructure

SB 138 Eslinger, Dist. 33, Wasola

- Modifies and creates new provisions related to agriculture

SB 157 Black, Dist. 12, Chillicothe

- Related to professions requiring a license

SB 186 Brown, Dist. 16, Rolla

- Related to public safety

SB 189 Luetkemeyer, Dist. 34, Parkville

- Related to criminal laws

SB 227 Coleman, Dist. 22, Jefferson County

- Related to the culpable mental state necessary for a homicide offense

SB 398 Schroer, Dist. 2, St. Charles County

- Enacts provisions related to motor vehicles (Pay sales tax on motor vehicles at purchase, “Siddens Bening Hands Free Law”, which prohibits a number of uses of electronic communication devices while driving, etc.)

SCR 7 Bernskoetter, Dist. 6, Jefferson Cit

- Creates the America 250 Missouri Commission

SCR 100 O’Laughlin, Dist. 18, Shelbina

- Authorizes the statutorily required independent audit of the State Auditor

SJR 26 Fitzwater, Dist. 10, Holts Summit

- Authorizes a property tax exemption for certain property used for child care

HB 115 Shields, Dist. 11, St. Joseph

- Related to licensing of health care professionals

HB 131 Griffith, Dist. 60, Jefferson City

- Allows state employees to be paid every two weeks

HB 447 Davidson, Dist. 130, Republic

- Established provisions regarding adult high schools, educational funding for students being treated a residential treatment facility and the enrollment of foster children in public school districts

HB 802 Dinkins, Dist. 802, Lesterville

- Authorizes the conveyance of certain state property
