

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Governor Parson signed the following bills into law last week.

- SB 39 establishes guidelines for student participation in sports organized by sex.
- SB 25 authorizes an income tax deduction for certain grant money.
- SB 49 establishes the "Missouri Save Adolescents From Experimentation (SAFE) Act".
- SB 13 modifies provisions relating to financial institutions.
- SB 167 specifies that medical examiner's certificates for commercial driver's licenses or permits may be provided to the state by mail, fax or email.
- SB 111 modifies provisions relating to the administration of state employees.
- HB 131 allows state employees to be paid biweekly.
