U.S. SCREENS HIGHEST NUMBER OF AIR PASSENGERS SINCE 2019

The U.S. Transportation Security Administration (TSA) said earlier this month that it had screened 2.785 million airline passengers on June 16, the highest number since before the COVID-19 pandemic. The TSA said it had screened approximately 10.6 million people from Friday through Monday, the Juneteenth holiday, giving an average of 2.67 million people per day.

Airlines reported few cancellations over the holiday period and the TSA said last Friday was the fourth-highest single-day for screenings ever and the highest since November 2019. The post-COVID 19 rebound looks set to continue, with industry group Airlines for America estimating a record 256.8 million passengers will fly in the June-August quarter, up 1% over the 254.6 million passengers in the same period in 2019.
