CEO Report:

John Groh reported:

- On the RACVB-produced/promoted Rockford Region Restaurant Week, Jan. 31 Feb. 6.
- The U.S. Figure Skating's Midwestern & Pacific Coast Synchronized Skating Sectional Championships is underway with 163 teams staying at 83 different hotels in the region. There is an opening reception on Thursday from 12 - 3:30 p.m. at BMO Center for partners and all board members are invited. The competition starts Thursday and concludes Sunday.
- Stroll on State 2023 saw attendance rise to 70,000+, an increase of 12.5 percent over 2021. Financial results were favorable, with an event income of approximately \$6,000. The Dasher Dash 5k also met financial projections.
- Public art opportunities at Davis Park: RACVB has worked with the Rockford Art Musesum to secure via longterm loan three scultpures from the State of Illinois that will be displayed at Davis Park or on other city-owned property. RACVB co-lead the process and will pay for the rigging and transportation to Rockford and will seek reimbursement from park development funds.
