





NJCAA Opening Weekend Tournament (OWT) returns with over 1,000 players

This largest-in-the nation women's collegiate volleyball tournament is expected to bring an estimated 4,100 visitors to region

What: The Rockford Area Convention & Visitors Bureau (RACVB) and Rockford Park District (RPD) are pleased to welcome back the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All in Volleyball Opening Weekend Tournament (OWT) to the Rockford region on August 18 – 20, 2023.

OWT is the largest two-year college women's volleyball tournament in the U.S. with teams comprised of athletes ages 18-21. Over 69 teams will be in attendance representing seventeen states including Illinois, Iowa, Indiana, Florida, and others. This is the fourth year of this event and the third time it has been in Rockford. The tournament is "match play", meaning the best of 3 of 5 games. This is an opportunity for media to conduct interviews and take photos at this elite **AII In Volleyball** sports tournament that will fill an estimated 700 hotel rooms with visitors projected to spend an estimated \$506,308.

Other: Advanced purchased tickets are \$10/day for ages 12 and older, \$5/day for seniors and children under 12 are free. General admission at the door is \$13/day. Concessions are available for purchase.

This is the largest volleyball tournament in the country for community colleges. New to the tournament this year is the addition of BallerTV, a youth sports broadcaster, who will be live streaming matches on all courts. Additional partners, Gipper Media, Hudl and NCSA will also be on site with live updates. The BIG 10 Conference has included a collection of international and nationally known referees and is utilizing the event as a line judge certification site to help with the professional development of future volleyball officials. Several hall of fame coaches and national champion coaches will be in attendance. OWT is proud to use local volleyball programs to help staff the event and has given more than \$16,000 to various fundraising efforts.
