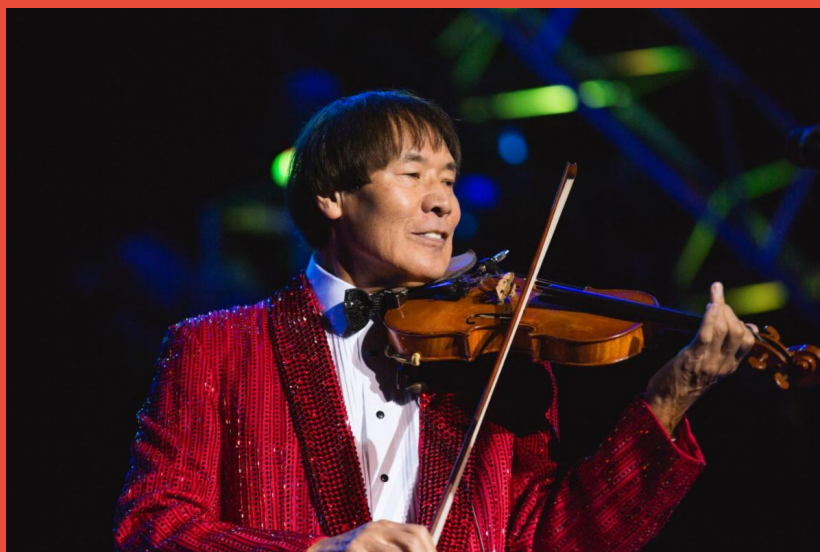

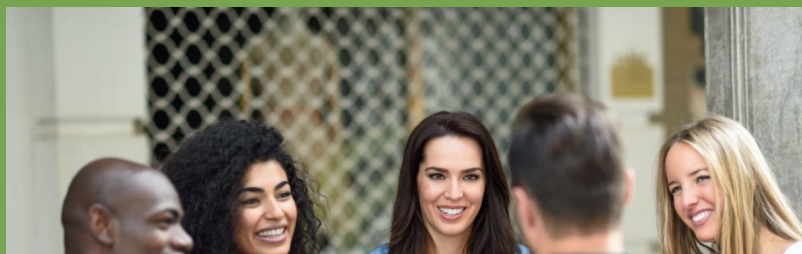
QUARTERLY IGNITE LUNCHEON AT BIG CEDAR LODGE
