HISTORY OF GOLF IN DUPAGE COUNTY AND AMERICA

DuPage County is home to the very first, and second, golf courses in America. This history starts with one man, Charles Blair Macdonald, who learned to play golf in Scotland at the Old Course on St. Andrew's in Fife. After designing a 7-hole golf course in conjunction with the 1892 Chicago World's Fair, Macdonald and his architect friend, Jarvis Hunt, wanted their own golf course. Macdonald raised funds and constructed the first 9-hole golf course in the U.S., located in Downers Grove — the original location of the Chicago Golf Club. Some historians believe that it was also the location of the first 18-hole golf course in the U.S., as Macdonald was said to have convinced Chicago Golf Club members to add nine more holes to its existing course.

The game, though new to the Chicago area, grew in popularity. The Club decided to buy land in nearby Wheaton where Macdonald modeled a new 18-hole golf course after the Old Course on St. Andrew's. It opened in 1895 and is also recorded as the first 18-hole golf course in the U.S. Today, Chicago Golf Club is continuously ranked as one of America's 100 greatest golf courses by Golf Digest. The original location in Downers Grove is still in operation, offering a 9-hole golf course under the name Belmont Golf Club. It is said that holes 2, 4, 7, 8 & 9 are still very much the same as they were 110 years ago. Despite which location is truly the site of the first 18-hole golf course, DuPage County holds a significant place in golf history.
