Additionally, Boone's episode of "A Taste of History" received a Bronze Telly in the Television – Food & Beverage category. Aired in 2023, the episode features Chef Walter Staib as he tries his hand at fly-fishing and connects with modern pioneers shaping the region's food culture.

The Telly Awards honors excellence in video and television across all screens and is judged by leaders from video platforms, television, streaming networks and production companies. Boone

joins winners including Adobe, Calvin Klein, ESPN, NASA, the LA Clippers (NBA), PlayStation Studios and more.
