Raise a glass to fine wine and inspiring art at the **33rd Annual Spring Wine Trail**, presented by **Park Place Lexus and Land Rover Grapevine**. The first 100 people will also get a blessed vine to take home.

Make it a whole wine weekend by riding the **Jazz Wine Train** on the Grapevine Vintage Railroad Friday, April 11 and stay in one of Grapevine's 20 hotels including Gaylord Texan Resort, Hilton DFW Lakes, the boutique Hotel Vin and other fantastic select-service hotels.
