Inclusive Swim Nights this Summer at Charleston County Waterparks and the West County Aquatic Center

For people with disabilities and their caregivers and families

[CHARLESTON COUNTY] – People with disabilities, their caregivers and families are invited to spend some refreshingly fun evenings at the waterparks and the pool this summer! The season's first event will be on May 31 at Splash Zone Waterpark, with other Inclusive Swim Nights taking place at the other waterparks and the West County Aquatic Center throughout the summer (see schedule below).

Inclusive Swim Nights take place on select dates after regular park hours, providing the opportunity for people with disabilities to experience the waterpark and pool amenities with smaller crowds. Guests can enjoy the sprays, slides and pools in a welcoming, sensory-friendly environment with lifeguards on duty to create a safe and fun evening.

Wheelchairs and water wheelchairs will be available for checkout during the events on a first-come, first-served basis. Accessible parking and restrooms will be available.

Registration is recommended and is available at CharlestonCountyParks.com or by calling 843-795-4386. A paid chaperone is required for all participants.
