Located at 1400 Old Towne Road in West Ashley, the 67-acre park offers the community the opportunity to enjoy recreation and beautiful open spaces, featuring accessible trails and boardwalks, scenic marsh views, a nature-inspired playground, and opportunities to learn about the site's history and ecology. The park officially opened to the public on June 30, 2026. Educational programming will also be offered at the site throughout the year.

Guests are encouraged to bring their own chairs or tables. Outside alcohol is prohibited at this event, but guests are permitted to bring their own food. A valid ID will be required to be served alcohol. Guests who will not be consuming alcohol may attend at no charge. Dogs are welcome, but must remain leashed at all times.
