GRAPEVINE CELEBRATES AMERICA'S 250TH BIRTHDAY WITH 44TH ANNUAL JULY 4TH FIREWORKS EXTRAVAGANZA

Historic Celebration will also honor Mayor William D. Tate's 50 years of leadership

GRAPEVINE, Texas (June 22, 2026) – Grapevine, Texas, will celebrate Independence Day in historic fashion on July 4, 2026, as the destination's 44th Annual Fireworks Extravaganza over Lake Grapevine commemorates both America's 250th birthday and Grapevine Mayor William D. Tate's 50 years of leadership.

For more than four decades, families and friends have gathered along the shores of Lake Grapevine to celebrate the nation's independence. This year's celebration starts at 9:30 p.m. and will feature a 17-minute super-premium pyro-musical orchestrated by Illumination Fireworks. The extravaganza will be complete with shells up to 8 inches in diameter, more than 1,300 breaking effects and a patriotic red, white and blue enhanced grand finale over Lake Grapevine.

Enhance your experience by streaming the synchronized patriotic soundtrack, featuring a blend of timeless classics and modern favorites. On July 4, visit GrapevineTexasUSA.com/July-4th-fireworks to find the audio player. As the fireworks begin, press play to enjoy the music alongside the show!

Catch the show from Grapevine Lake Parks which will require a \$20 per vehicle fee on July 4.

- Rockledge Park (3600 Pilot Point) - \$20 entry fee per vehicle (No In/Out)
- Katie's Woods Park (1700 Katie's Woods Dr.) \$20 entry fee per vehicle (No In/Out)
- Mariner Point Park (1 Sunfish Dr.) - \$20 entry fee per vehicle (No In/Out)

Distant/obstructed viewing areas:

- Meadowmere Park (3000 Meadowmere Ln.) - \$20 entry fee per vehicle (No In/Out)
- McPherson Slough (2500 Catfish Ln.) - No Fee
- Lakeview Park (3850 Lakeview Dr.) - \$20 entry fee per vehicle (No In/Out)

Boater/Trailer Parking at Boat Ramps is \$20 each.

Parks fill up quickly, so visitors are encouraged to arrive early and stay all day to enjoy the festivities. Once the parking lots are full, no additional vehicles will be admitted. Marina members are not required to pay but must also arrive early to guarantee entry. [Click here](#) for updates on closures as they are announced.
