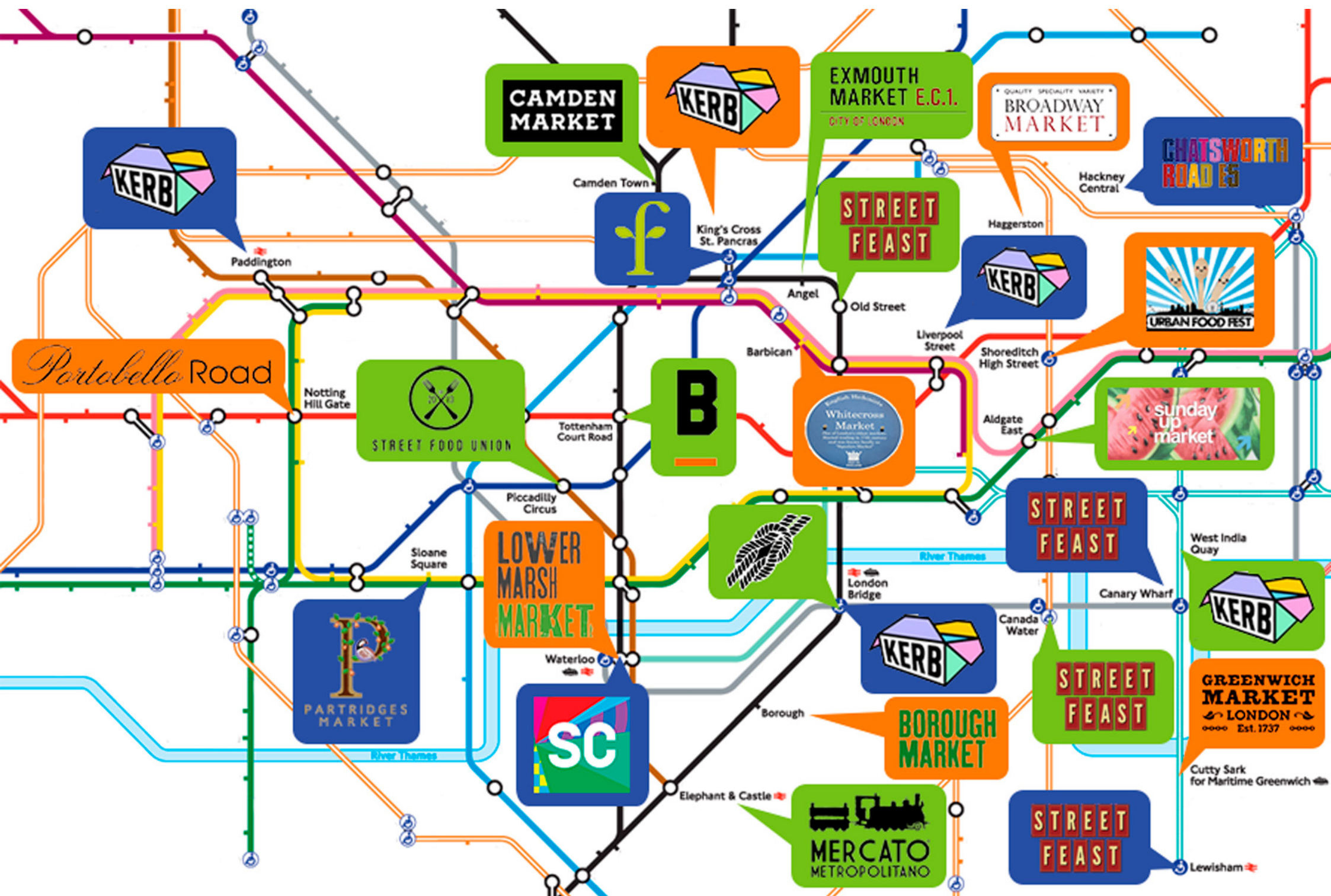


LONDON PERMANENT FOOD MARKETS' MAP

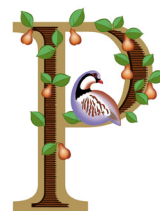
