**Broadway** is a market with great history, and this is something you will instantly feel when visiting it. While in 1900 it was possible to buy jellied eels, during the eighties many people moved out, and the food market dies until 2004 when the volunteers from the community revived this market full of character and delicious food stalls.



In the 1930s **Chatsworth Market** was a lifeful local market with over 200 stalls, but the number of stalls gradually reduced until it was closed down around 1990. The community reopened it again in 2011, and it has been running weekly since then.
