There will be 4 - 5 sections set out ranging from Intro through Black Plate and some easy white routes to keep the kids busy. A skid area will be set out for those wanting to show off their talents and a "How Slow Can You Go" downhill balance challenge.

Safety Gear Requirement: Helmet; Long sleeve top/jersey and Long pants; Off road boots - ideally of leather or similar durable material and of a length that overlaps the pant legs when seated on a bike; gloves are not mandatory but use them if you have them. Body Armour is not needed for trials but if you have it already, then all will be good. We may have some odd bits of riding gear available to borrow or share. Also, make sure you bring sunscreen, sunhats and water!
