# MAX PUNCH<sup>™</sup> 360<sup>°</sup> HYDRAULIC PUNCH

#### SETUP AND OPERATION

1. Use a step bit to drill the pilot holes.



- 2. Make sure that the hydraulic pressure valve is in the off position
- 3. Screw the draw stud into the articulating head. For 1/2" punch use the 7/16" draw stud, for a 3/4" - 2" punch use the 3/4" draw stud, and for a  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " – 4" punch use the 1<sup>1</sup>/8" draw stud.



#### SETUP AND OPERATION

4. Insert cup on to draw stud facing panel.



5. Insert draw stud through pilot hole.



6. Screw on cutter.



- 7. Make sure that all three cutter points on the cutter are tight to the panel.
- 8. Close pressure valve by turning clockwise to the ON position.



9. Position the articulating head to a comfortable position.

10. Begin operating the pump, stop compressing when knock out is complete.



- 11. Release pressure valve, by turning counter clockwise to the OFF position.
- 12. Unscrew cutter die to release slug.



### ADDITIONAL HELP

• There is a 1/2" spacer available for convenience but not necessary to complete the knockout.

A CAUTION: • Do not rotate the articulating head during the pumping process.
• Release pressure in the hydraulic system when not in use.

#### MAINTENANCE

Maintain appropriate hydraulic fluid capacity by adding or changing hydraulic fluid as needed for proper pressure.

#### AWARNING : Too much hydraulic fluid will cause the MP360HP to not work correctly

- 1. Unscrew the hydraulic cylinder.
- 2. Pinch bladder end with one hand while pulling out the plug with a pair of pliers.
- 3. Add hydraulic fluid; leave a ½" 1" space between the hydraulic fluid level and end of the bladder.
- 4. Replace plug.
- 5. Replace hydraulic cylinder.
