FHI SCORE

The Philips inaugural *Future Health Index* (FHI) report measures the level and preparedness of connected care across selected countries from every continent. It is split into three sub-indices: access to the healthcare system; the current state of health integration; and adoption of connected care technology. The index ranges from 0 to 100 and is the average score of the three sub-indices

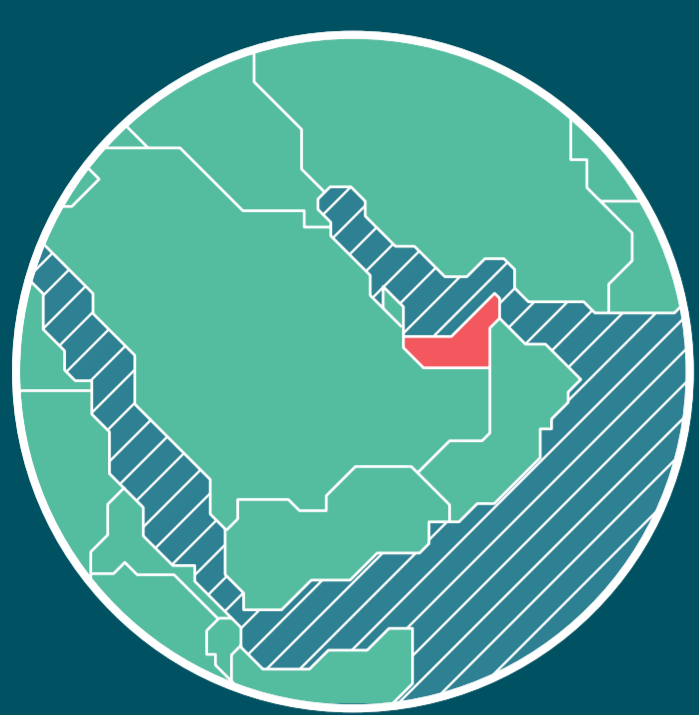
Perceived level of access for all people to a range of healthcare solutions and services across all health needs

INTEGRATION

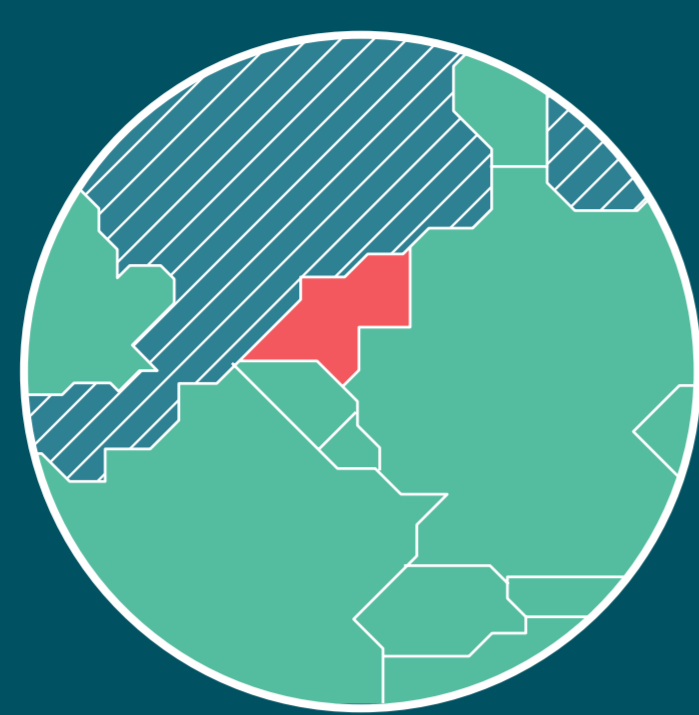
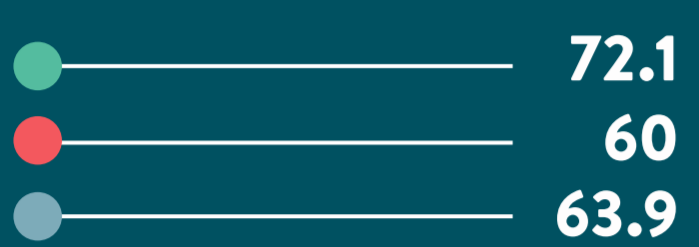
Perceived state of functional integration and interoperability between healthcare systems

ADOPTION

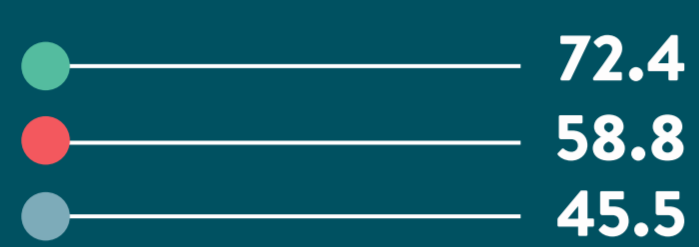
Perceived proliferation, take-up, use of and familiarity with connected care technology



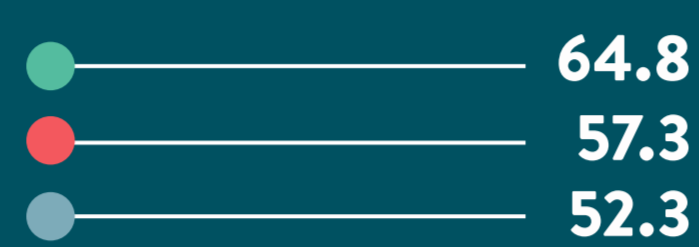

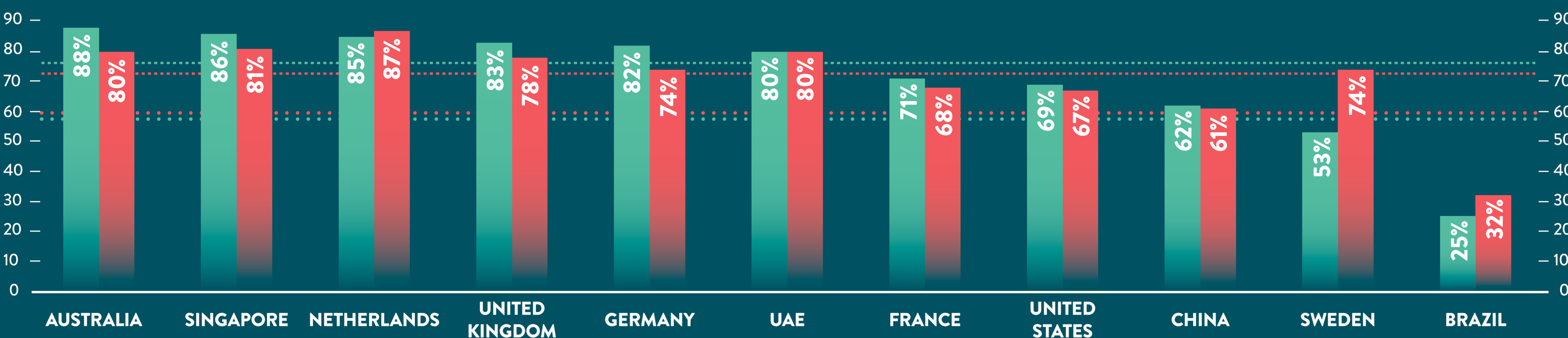

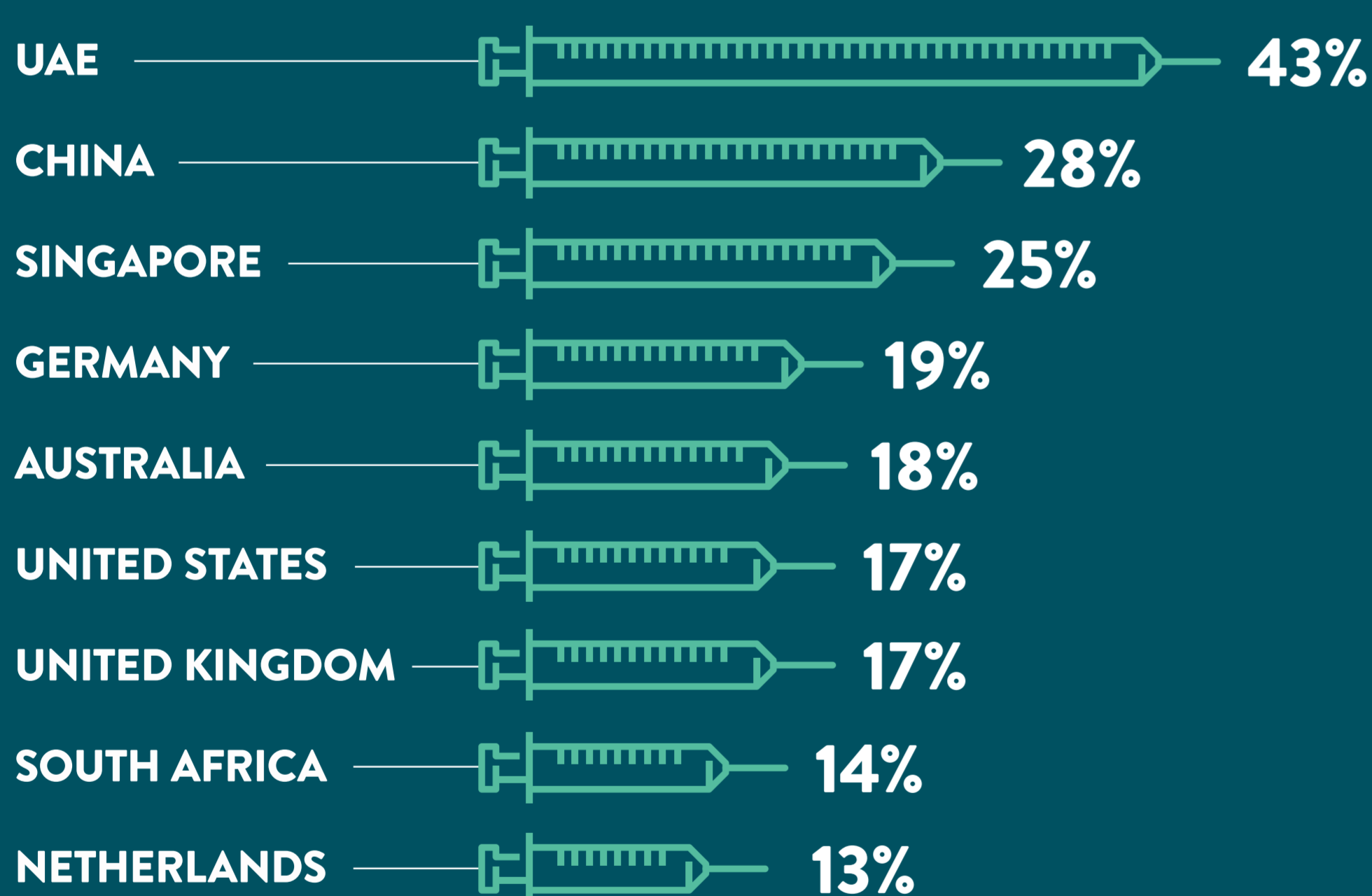

INTEGRATION OF HEALTH SYSTEMS

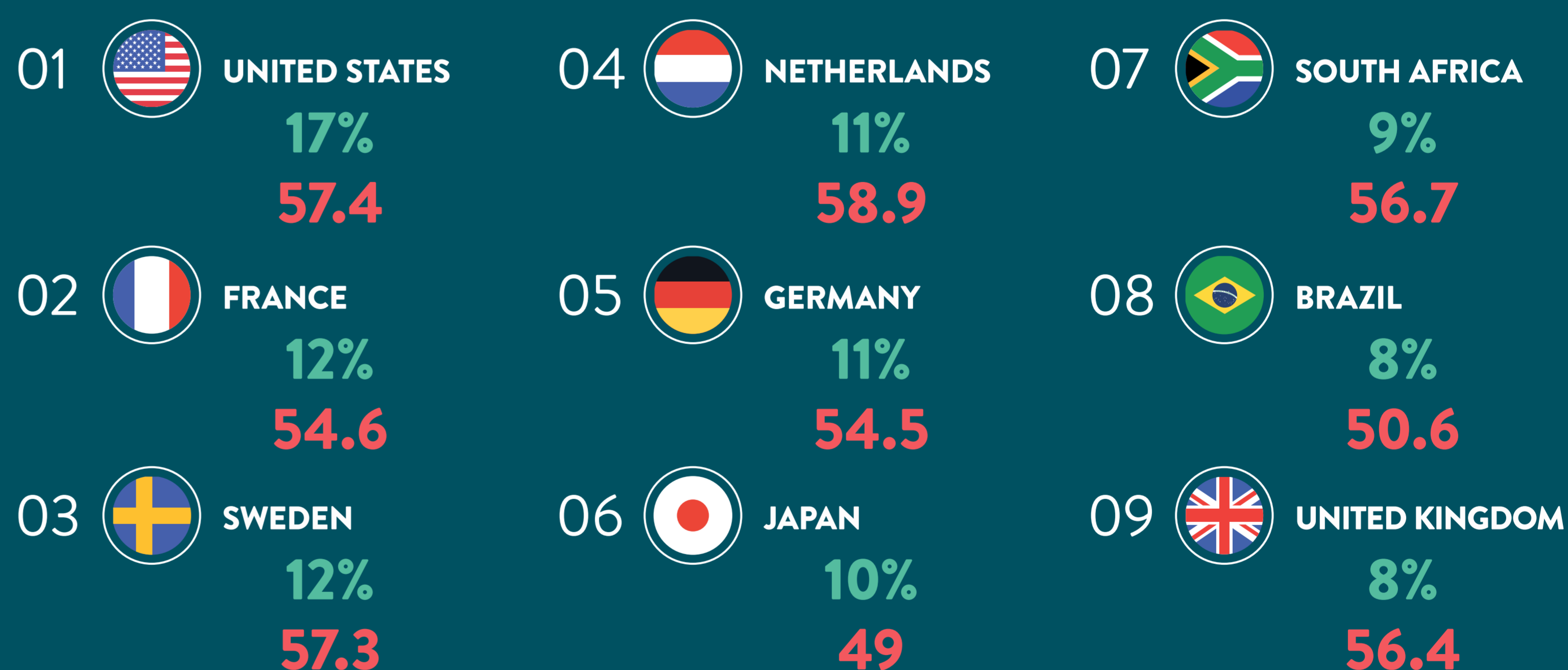
PERCENTAGE OF PATIENTS WHO BELIEVE HEALTH SYSTEMS ARE VERY/COMPLETELY INTEGRATED

Healthcare spending as a percentage of GDP

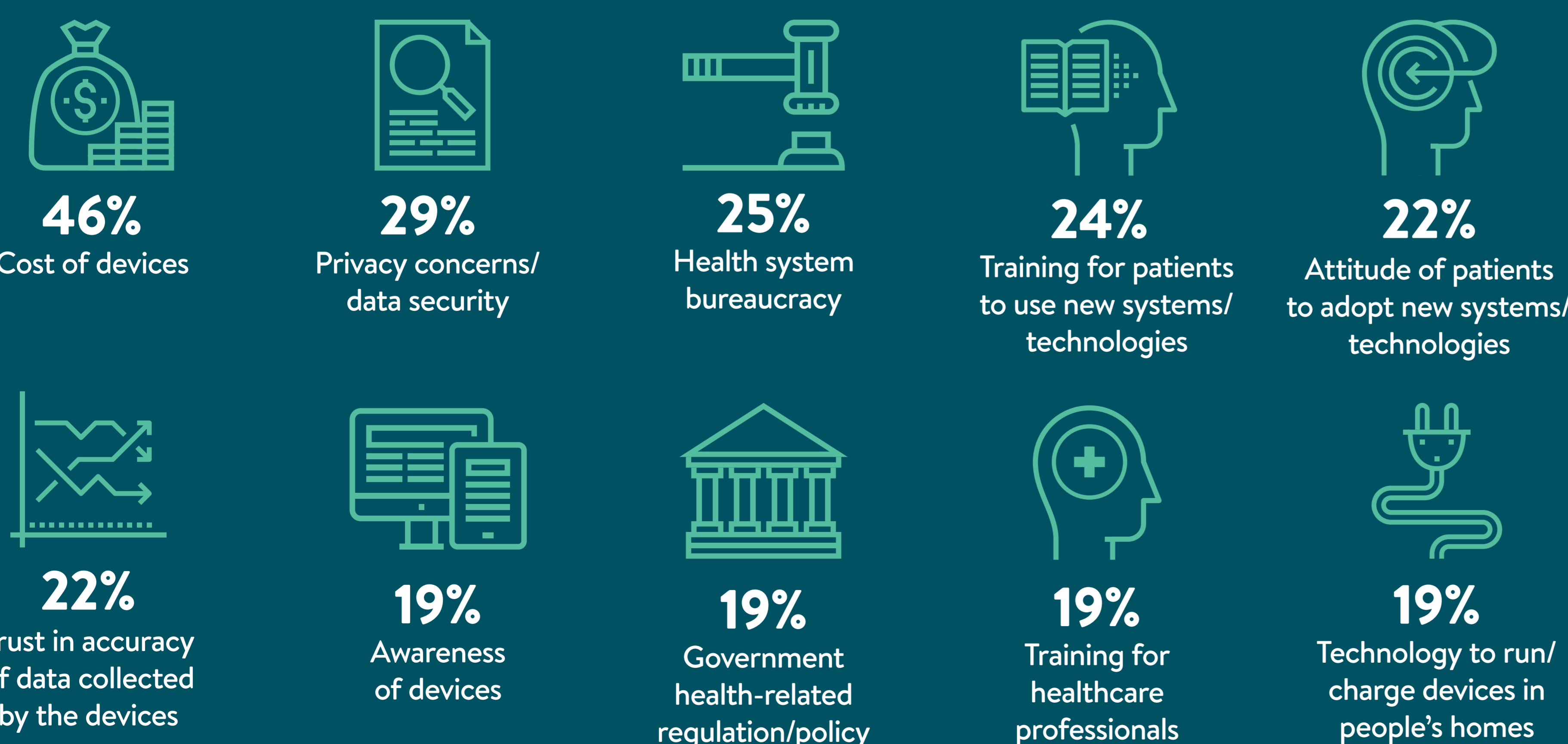

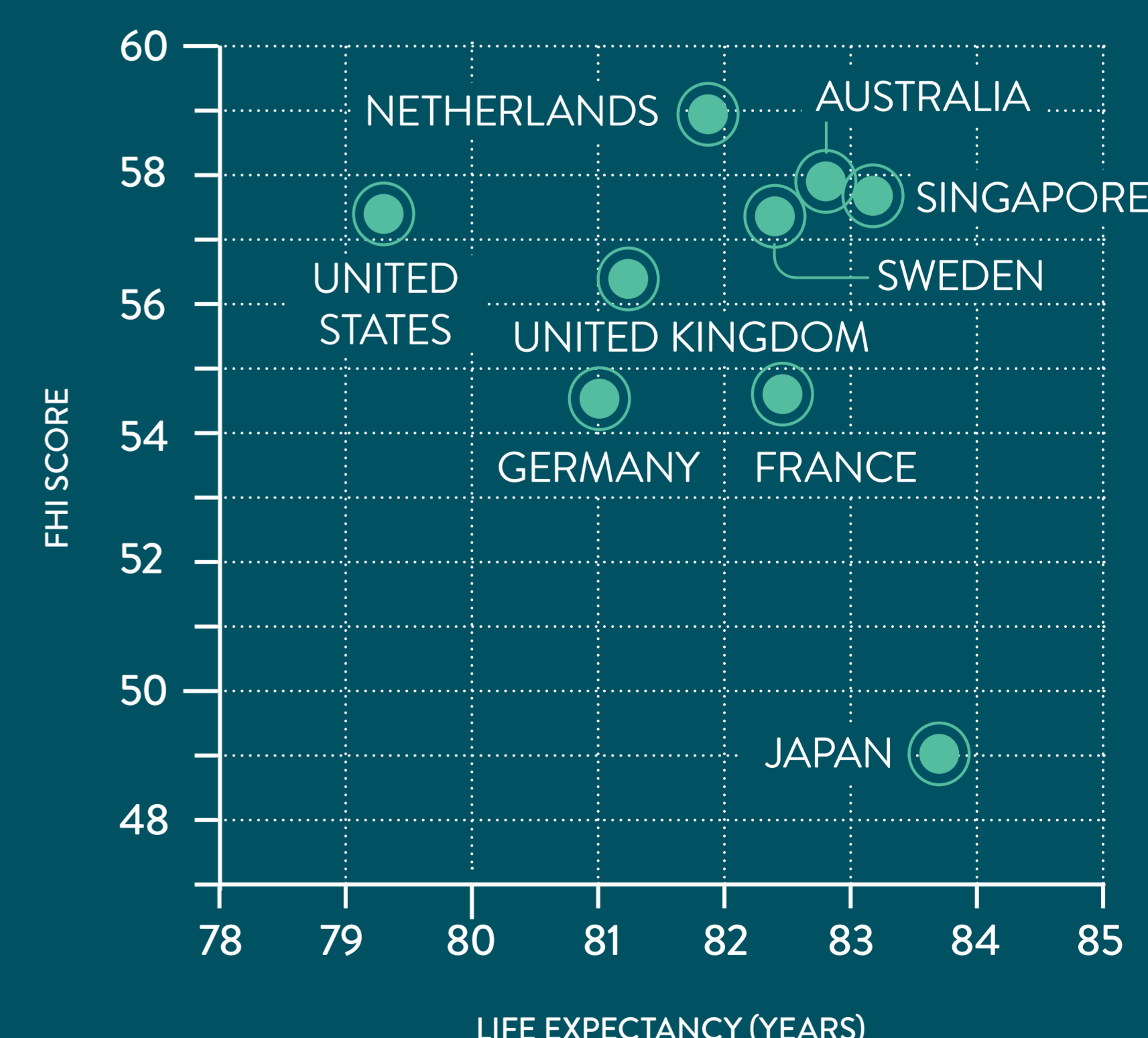
